Legislative victories

Buy America (HB 3332, 2023)

Buy Clean (HB 4131, 2022) Passed with bipartisan support in the House and Senate, Buy Clean is a procurement tool that aims to promote less carbon intensive materials by requiring contractors to submit Environmental Product Declarations for steel, cement, and asphalt products used in transportation projects.

Clean Energy Career Opportunities: Refinement Bill (HB 4059, 2022) Legislation updated the Oregon prevailing wage definition, added clarity on PLA's meeting minimum standards, and clarified the "good faith effort" clause in reporting PLA submission to the Oregon PUC.

100% Oregon Clean Energy Opportunities (HB 2021, 2021) BGA joined environmental justice organizations, environmental policy organizations, industry, and investor owned utilities to set a 100% Clean Energy target for 2040 with an 80% emissions reduction goal by 2030. Additionally, BlueGreen Alliance was instrumental in working with labor, utilities, and renewable energy groups to develop some of the strongest renewable energy project labor standards in the country:
